



# CRAPAUD H3 REPORT

For the first time in my hashing history, though maybe not the first time ever, the run was from Battery Moltke at Les Landes. An unusual venue, as it really was in the middle of nowhere in the wilds of St Ouen.

The trail was originally planned by Muff Diver for his run in June but the threat of rifle fire meant postponement and Muff Diver's subsequent knee injury meant a handover of the reins to Twin Peaks – rather apt as we were going to pass very close to the race course.

The pack gathered in a timely manner but were held at bay to give a visiting hasher (Royal Prick, also known as Mike) a chance to join up with the group. Unfortunately he wasn't aware of the change of venue from the model aircraft carpark to Battery Moltke but realised he was in the wrong place when no one else turned up – anyway he had the good sense to call the hare and was soon put on the right track and able to join us.

The weather was looking very grim and murky but this didn't deter the pack and they soon set off in good spirits towards the site where the old Bal Tabarin nightclub once stood.

Wendowlene had been advised of the route and was able to steer the runners towards Maison des Landes and down a very long but not too muddy track. From here it was a fairly long loop on the road taking in Rue Freule, Rue de la Trappe and Route des Landes before cutting back across tracks and fields and rejoining the Les Landes headland via Rue de la Landelle.

The trail led the runners to the north of Les Landes race track and eventually onto the cliff path which finally brought them to Gronez castle. From here the pack was advised to keep the rifle range to their left and follow the sawdust trail which kept them for the most part away from the cliff edge and ultimately back to the carpark and food – and drink too of course.

This week we had a good mix of runners and walkers (16 in total) and the hares were very thankful that so many turned up on such a dismal day.

Down downs were awarded to the hares for laying the trail, to Wendowlene for once again being our third hare, to Plonker for his first appearance this year and to Royal Prick, a returning visiting runner.
